**R. Daniel Kelemen** is Professor of Political Science and Jean Monnet Chair in European Union Politics at Rutgers University. Kelemen's research interests include the politics of the European Union, law and politics, comparative political economy, and comparative public policy. His most recent book 'Eurolegalism: The Transformation of Law and Regulation in the European Union' (Harvard University Press 2011) won the 'Best Book Award' from the European Union Studies Association. He is editor of 'Lessons from Europe? What Americans Can Learn from European Public Policies' (CQ Press 2014) and co-editor of 'The European Union: Integration and Enlargement' (Routledge 2014), 'The Power of the European Court of Justice' (Routledge 2012), and 'The Oxford Handbook of Law and Politics' (Oxford University Press 2008). He serves on the editorial boards of the 'Journal of European Public Policy' and



'West European Politics' and is a former member of the Executive Committee of the European Union Studies Association.
